GENERAL INSTALLATION NOTES

- Version 16 program install and program-related files can be downloaded from <u>www.kurzweiledu.com/k3win</u>. Or, a DVD or USB can be used for installation.
- When installing or uninstalling on computers with Windows 7, 8, 8.1, or 10 you must be logged on as administrator or as a user with administrator privileges.
- Prior to installing Kurzweil 3000, ensure that there are no pending Microsoft updates; if there are, those installations should be completed first.
- Whenever installing a combination of Kurzweil 3000 and Kurzweil 1000 (reading system for the blind), always install the older version first, based on the date on the DVD.
- The Standalone Edition Trial version can no longer be activated to the full product. For the full Standalone Edition product, you must install from the separate product download, or DVD, and register the product.
